



GLAZIERS' VISIT TO ENO: 'CARMEN' ON THURSDAY 6 FEBRUARY 2020

The Master is pleased to announce the first outing of her tenure is to see ENO's 2nd revival production of Bizet's *Carmen* on **6th February 2020** at The London Coliseum, St. Martin's Lane, London, WC2N 4ES.

Composed by Bizet in 1875 *Carmen* is a searing depiction of a woman who craves love, but creates obsession and jealousy based on the infamous novella by Prosper Mérimée. One of the most popular operas ever written, Bizet's score is bursting with passionate melodies and includes such famous arias as the 'Habanera', 'Toreador's Song' and 'Flower Song'.



Returning in the title role is sensational mezzo Justina Gringytė. Rising stars Sean Panikkar (José) and Nardus Williams (Micaëla) make their ENO debuts. Making a welcome return to the company is Ashley Riches as Escamillo. The cast is rounded out by ENO Harewood Artists Samantha Price, Matthew Durkan and Alex Otterburn.
